### Prompt

Select a passage in Schiller's letters on aesthetic education that you think is important and write a short commentary on its significance. What ideas does it introduce or engage? What do you find significant about it? Where does it lead your thinking? How does it speak to the theme of aesthetics?

### Details+

Follow these steps to produce your text:

1. Download the "Standard Manuscript Format" file from the website (see Documents page)
2. Delete the writing in the body of the document and replace the author information in the top left with your own
3. Write your commentary
4. Print the document out and bring it to class on Thursday (1/31)
